A graduate of ENA (National School of Administration), he managed several missions related to economic interventions within the Ministry of Finance from 1984 till 1986. From 1986 till 1991, he served in the Ministry of Trade and Craft Industry successively as Technical Advisor then Craft Industry Director. From 1991 till 1995, Jérôme Bédier developed international missions as an associate for the Deloitte & Touche organization. From 1995 till 2011, he served as Executive President of the Federation of Trade and Retail (FCD). In parallel, he worked in the office of the MEDEF where he also held a seat on the Board; during that period, he also worked as Vice-president for Eurocommerce. In 2011, Jérôme Bédier joined Capgemini Consulting France as Vice-president, in charge of development, especially in the areas of mass-consumption and trade.
